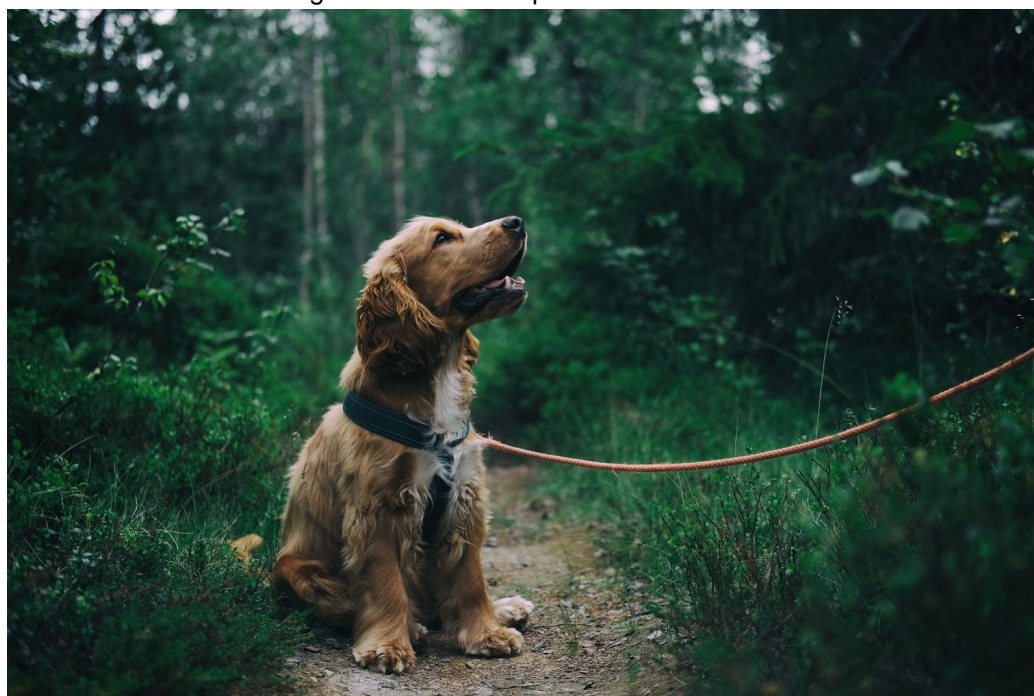
Lesson 2 - Walking the dog
